DUE DATES

To be on track, large hospitals (>500 cases/yr.) typically would be expected to have abstracted January 2022 diagnosis cases by August 15, 2022. Smaller facilities (<300 cases /yr.) would be expected to have reported the 4th Quarter of 2021 by July 15, 2022.

The **NAACCR CTR Exam Preparation and Review Webinar Series** offers online interactive instruction with live instructors.
