Correction: LVI can upstage Testis from T1 to T2 not SEER Summary Stage 1 to 2

Testis Stage

- Code SEER Summary Stage 1 (localized only) for tumors limited to the testis WITH OR WITHOUT lymphovascular invasion
 - o AJCC T1
- Code SEER Summary Stage 2 (Regional by direct extension only) WITH OR WITHOUT lympho-vascular invasion (LVI)
 - AJCC T2 LVI can upstage testis from T1 to T2

• Code SEER Summary Stage 4 (Regional by BOTH direct extension (WITH OR WITHOUT lympho-vascular invasion (LVI) AND regional lymph node(s) involved)

The National Cancer Registrars Association (NCRA) salutes the Senate passage of the *Counting Veterans' Cancer Act of 2023*, included as an amendment to the Senate Veterans Affairs Appropriations Bill, *H.R.4366* – the Military Construction, Veterans Affairs, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act. Data Use Agreements are **no longer needed** to collect data from Veterans Healthcare facilities.
