To be on track, large hospitals (>500 cases/yr.) typically would be expected to have abstracted November 2021 diagnosis cases by June 15, 2022. Smaller facilities (<300 cases /yr.) would be expected to report the 4th Quarter of 2021 by July 15, 2022.

NEW Breast Surgery codes for 2022

New breast surgery and reconstruction codes are required for breast cases diagnosed in 2022 only. Detailed information and coding examples can be found in the attached Show-Me-Tip created by Babette.

Macroscopic Evaluation of the Mesorectum

This new data item should be collected on all cases regardless of the date of diagnosis. Macroscopic pathologic assessment of the completeness of the mesorectum, scored as complete, partially complete, or incomplete accurately predicts both local recurrence and distant metastasis. Refer to the attached Show-Me-Tip for details.
