To be on track, large hospitals (>500 cases/yr.) typically would be expected to have abstracted April 2022 diagnosis cases by November 15, 2022. Smaller facilities (<300 cases /yr.) would be expected to have reported the 1st Quarter of 2022 by October 15, 2022.
