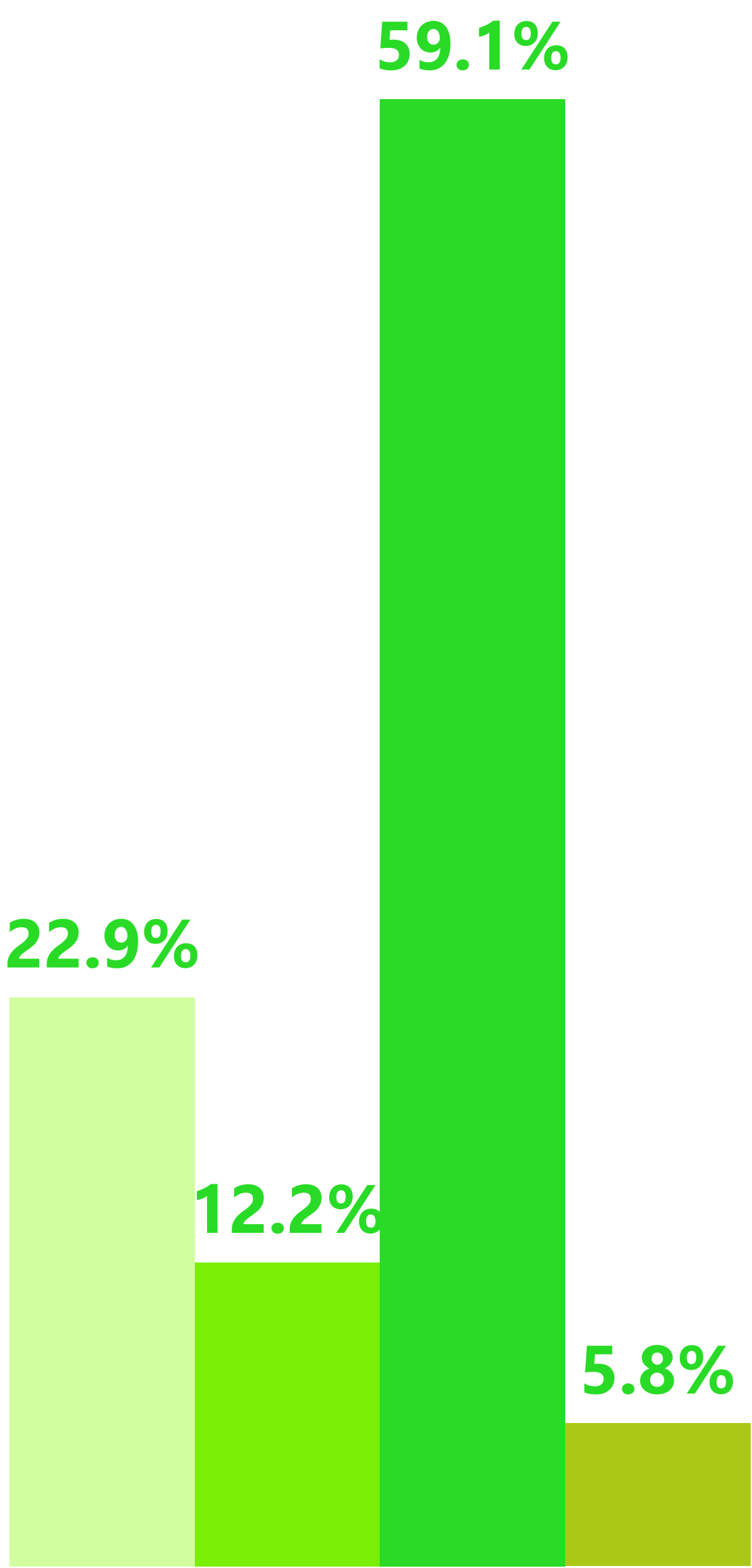

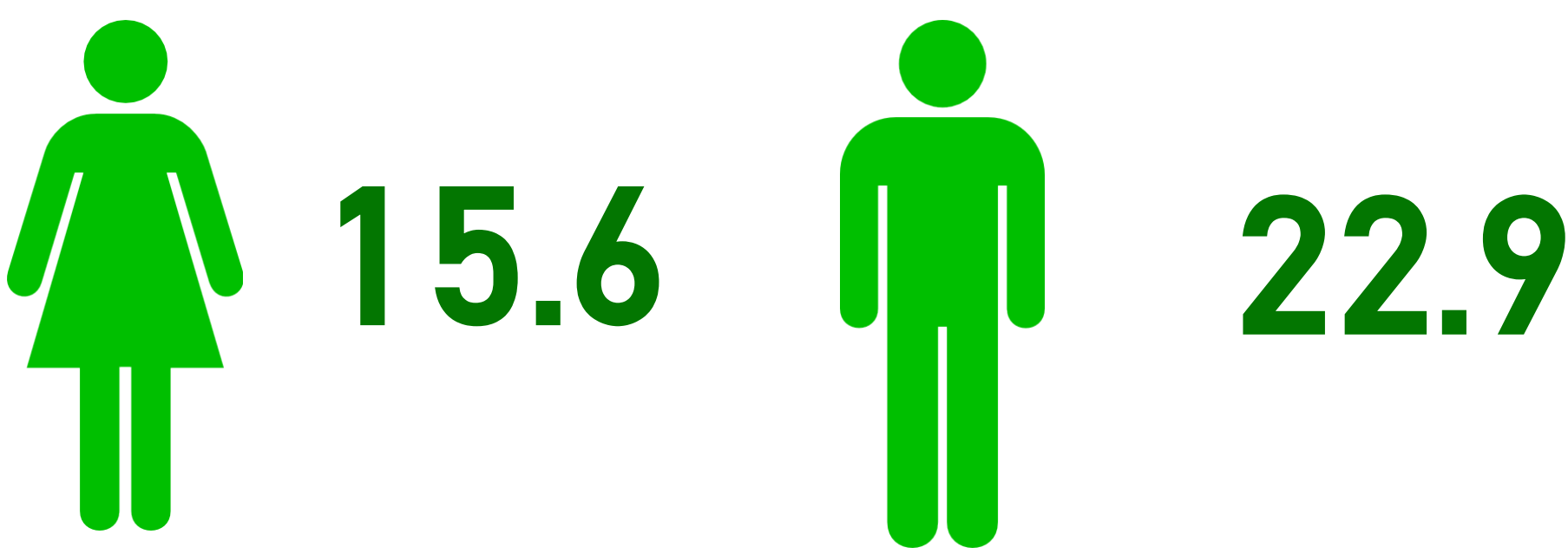

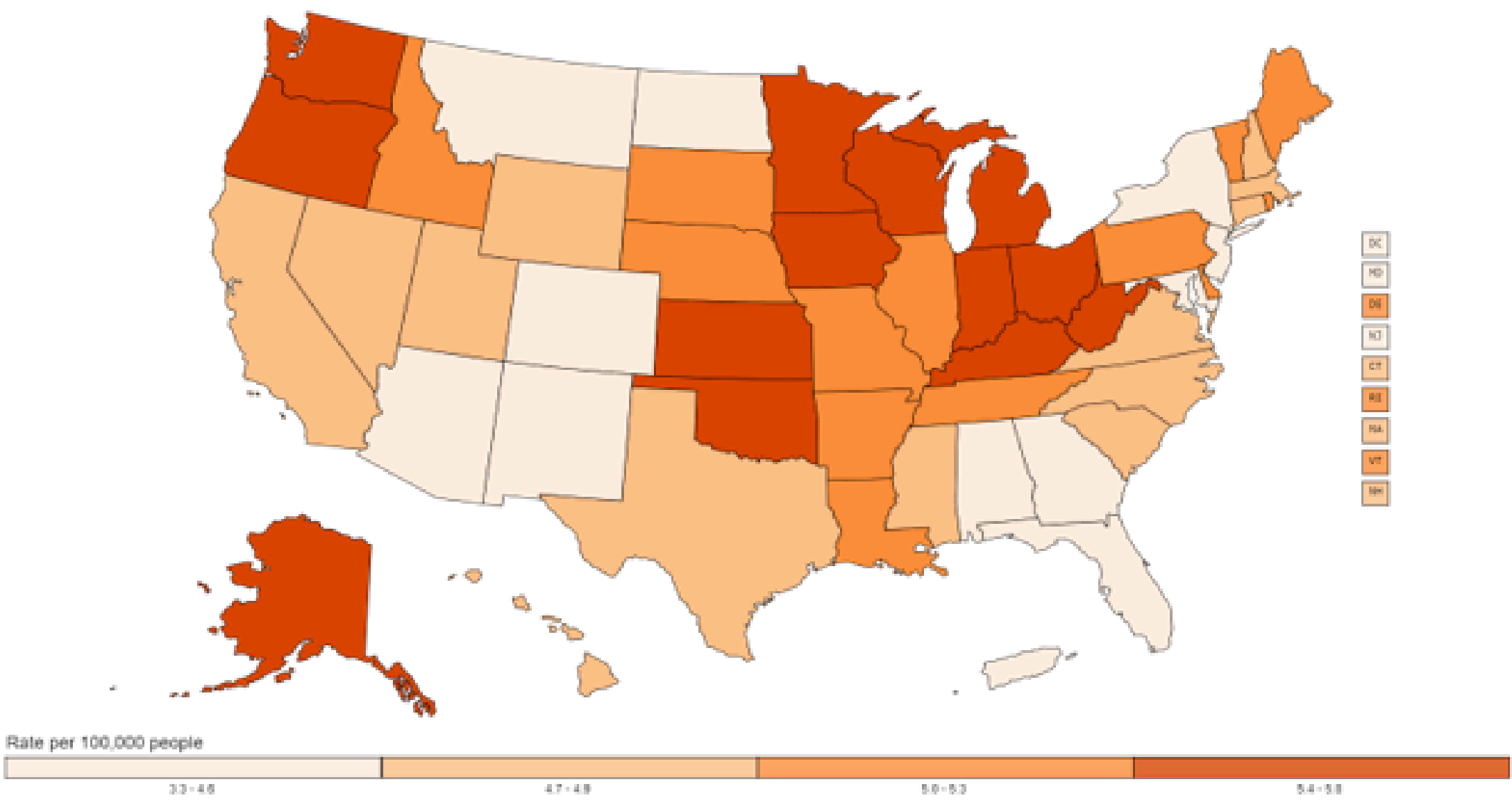
Stage\*% Distribution
